Palette:

(Professional quality paints)

ultramarine blue

alizerine crimson

cadmium yellow

titanium white

ivory black

May be added:

cad. or naphthol red, cerulean blue or cobalt blue, yellow ochre,
raw umber

Brushes:

Long flats and/or filberts, natural bristle: #2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and a rigger for details.

Panels:

His preference: oil primed panels from Centurion, called OP DLX
(Jerry's Artarama)

Several smallish sizes (8 X 10 or 9 X 12) and one 16 X 20 canvas which can be taped off for small studies

Solvent:

Gamsol by Gamblin

Other Supplies:

portable easel,

bug spray

palette knife,

wide brimmed hat

Viva paper towels,

sunscreen

Brush cleaner

sack lunch and beverage
