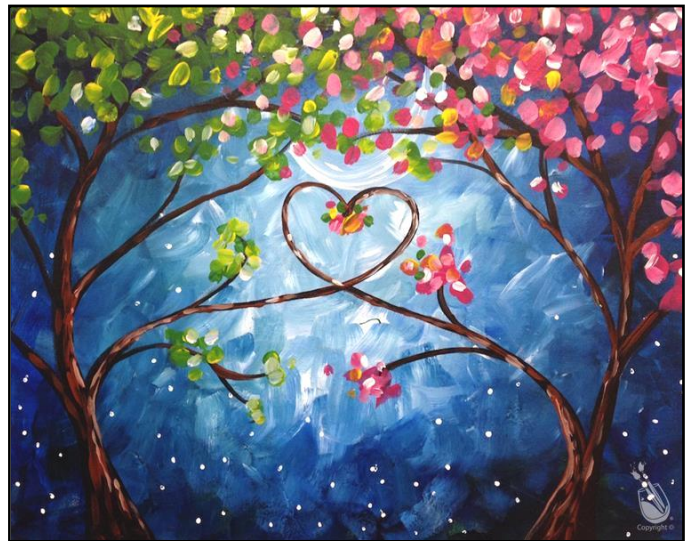

"My Mother is a wonderful artist," Tina says, "so I grew up with a love of arts and crafts of all kinds. As a child, weekends were spent making candles, pottery, and also painting, and drawing."

In 12th grade, Tina had a marvelous teacher, Mrs. King, who influenced her love of art even more. In college, she took every art class she could, including painting, pottery, and sculpting.

For as long as she can remember, she has loved art. Tina is interested in teaching a *Family History Heirlooms* class and a *Beginner Jewelry Making* class.

Tina has been a member of NCAA for three years. She has given very generously her time and talent in support of NCAA events and other collaborative efforts in the art community. She also belongs to a photography club, hiking club, and a knitting group.



In 2016, her painting "Still Life" was chosen for Top Ten recognition at the NCAA Juried Member Art Exhibit. It was the first Art Show she had ever entered, and she

GENERAL MEETING MINUTES - JANUARY 2018

A general meeting of the Newnan-Coweta Art Association ("NCAA"), was called to order by President Tammy Troyer at 7:35 pm, on Thursday, January 25, 2018, at the Harriet Alexander Art Center. (This meeting had been postponed from the original date of January 18, 2018, due to inclement weather.)

Ruth Whitaker installed 2018 Board members Margo Merrifield (Vice President) and Jenny Jones (Director), who were unable to attend the Installation of Officers & Directors conducted prior to the start of the January 8, 2018, Board Meeting.

President Troyer welcomed members, new members, and guests.

Door Prize drawing was for an art piece by demonstrator Shakeyla Shinholster and was won by Sandy Adams (mother/guest of Teresa Foshee).

President Troyer thanked members Barbara Kelly, Barbara Omerod, Ronda Schwenning, and Joan Wende for providing refreshments.

Suzanne Kleese-Stamps, Secretary, reported that the minutes of November 2017 General Meeting were electronically filed and published in the (combined) December 2017/January 2018 newsletter.

Cheryl Hipke, on behalf of Fred Buyarski, Treasurer, reported NCAA account balances as follows:

Value Checking (PP/FB Trx)	\$ 754.43;
Value Checking	\$ 2,761.36;
Business Savings	\$ 505.68; and
Money Market	\$ 138,602.59.

Total account balances \$142,624.06. The Treasurer's report was approved and filed.

The Audit Committee comprised of Suzanne Kleese-Stamps, Cheryl Hipke (filling in for Teresa Foshee), and Fred Buyarski, conducted an audit on January 9, 2018 of NCAA 2017 financial records. The committee reported no issues for the audit period and flagged two outstanding checks that had not been cashed. The committee signed and submitted the Audit report.

President Troyer announced that the Budget Committee (Fred Buyarski, Tammy Troyer, Jenny Jones, and Barbara Omerod) will meet on February 2, 2018, at Corner Arts Gallery to finalize the Proposed 2018 Budget. The budget will include planning for the 50th Anniversary celebration of NCAA at the Juried Art Show Reception in June 2018.

Cheryl Hipke, on behalf of Membership Chairman, Fred Buyarski, reported a total of 191 members on the roster; of those, 53 memberships are expired for a total of 138 members in good standing.

Sponsorship — Teresa Foshee reported the status of NCAA sponsorships and introduced a new campaign, "Each One Get One". Campaign stickers and sponsorship packets were distributed to each member present with the goal for each one to sign up a sponsor in 2018. Packets include sponsorship form, cover letter, and information about NCAA. There are a total of 17 sponsors - of those, 8 will expire in May (but will still be included in the Juried Art Show printed materials). Another 9 will expire in June. Teresa will begin contacting the sponsors one month prior to their expiry dates. A sign-up sheet was available for members to recommend potential sponsors, in the event they prefer to have Teresa follow up with the request. NCAA thanked Teresa for her diligence with our Sponsorship Program.

Website & Social Media — Suzanne Kleese-Stamps reported on calendar updates for 2018 that include classes and art shows. Also, Main Street Newnan has placed a 'call to artists' to refresh their information on the ListServ database and apply to participate in the Market Days and Spring Art Walk. Suzanne encouraged members to provide information on classes they are teaching for inclusion on a "Classes" page on the website. Email: newnancowetaartassociation@gmail.com with details.

BUSINESS ITEMS:

NCAA By-Laws Committee — President Troyer reported that amendments to the By-Laws have been drafted and will be voted on by the Board at the February Board Meeting. Pending approval, the proposed By-Laws will be provided in writing to the general membership for review and voted on at the March 15, 2018 General Meeting.

"Newnan, A Storybook Town" Fiberglass Art Project — President Troyer provided an update. 22 art pieces have been purchased by project sponsors. January 31, 2018 is the payment deadline to ChildrenConnect Museum. Bette Hickman & Pamela Prange will meet with artists on February 27 to announce the sponsors and pair them up with artists. The fiberglass will be delivered to the Art House on March 5. Expected artist completion is May 15. A dedication Reception is planned for May 27, and installation of art in Newnan on June 1. The ad hoc committee for the piece ("pig") sponsored by NCAA are Barbara Omerod, Suzanne Kleese-Stamps, Cheryl Hipke, and Tammy Troyer.

Mural at/for CCS Burwell Program (Headstart) — Tammy Troyer was contacted by CCS Burwell Program and asked if NCAA could paint a mural for them (as we had done at DFCS playground last year). Burwell is a program for children with behavioral issues to get them focused and back in the mainstream schools. It includes elementary, middle, and high school students. A sign-up sheet was made available for artists interested in painting the mural, and Tammy will have more information prior to the February meeting.

Because of his painting ability and observation of nature, he is able to make fish carvings that are meticulously detailed and lifelike in appearance. His fish carvings range in size from tie-pin to life-size. He carves many species of fish, including saltwater and freshwater fish.

Cecil and his wife, Maxine, live in Newnan and are grandparents to three children. He is active in Central Baptist Church and also enjoys gardening, photography, and fly fishing. He has been a long-time member of NCAA and participates in several art shows each year.

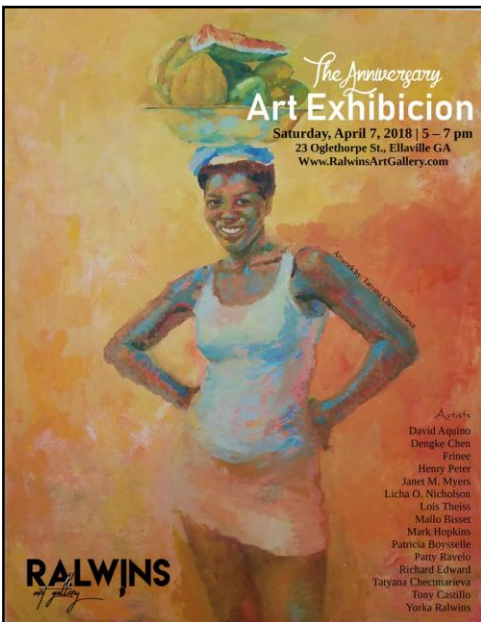
