President Troyer extended a warm welcome to members, new members, and guests. She thanked members Cheryl Hipke, Suzanne Kleese-Stamps, Barbara Kelly, and Rae Duncan for providing refreshments.

Guest presenter Natalie Schorr donated 4 door prizes. Each winner received an original "Fabulous Fishy" 3-color linoleum relief (hand painted) Christmas card/ornament. The winners were: Cheryl Hipke, Claudia Tucker, Michael Watford, and Barbara Kelly.

Suzanne Kleese-Stamps (Recording Secretary) reported that the minutes of September 2018 General Meeting were electronically filed and published in the October 2018 newsletter.




