The day we had art class was always my favorite day of the week in elementary school. I took all of the art classes that were available in junior high and high school. For college, I choose Kent State University in Ohio because it had a large, well known art department.

Once I decided to go into art education, I had a hard time balancing my own need to create art with the time and energy that was required to teach art to young children. I struggled to do both for my first 5 or 6 years of teaching. It was frustrating and exhausting. I knew I had to choose one or the other. After much reflection, I choose to "give" my creativity and love of art to children. Once I made the choice, I never looked back.

I have taught art in both public and private schools, art galleries, craft stores, recreation centers, and one junior college for about 25 years. I have taught every age group from kindergarten to adults, but mostly I have stayed with the elementary school age group. I love teaching them new skills and seeing their joy in creating something that is beyond what they thought they could do.

### BUSINESS ITEMS:

The NCAA can now plan accordingly; awaiting confirmation of four collaborative opportunities between October 2025 and March 2026.
