#### SPECIFICATIONS AND CONDITIONS

Only NCAA members in good standing are eligible to enter 2D or 3D artwork. NO entry fee is required and only one submission per artist! Submitted artwork must be original in concept and design and suitable for viewing by any audience. **Artwork must be themed:** i.e., Musical: orchestras, fiddles, bagpipes, or related to Scotland: i.e., nature, cultural, historical or architectural.

All entries must be professionally framed or Gallery Wrap canvas (not less than 2 inches) with hanging wire attached on the back. Framed or Gallery Wrap pieces may not exceed 24" x 24" and must be a minimum of 12" x 12" in size. Artists may not substitute another work for an accepted work or withdraw accepted work. Title and price will not be changed after submission.

Artwork must have been completed within the last four years. "Prints" are not eligible for entry. **Artwork must remain in the exhibit until Saturday, July 22, 2023.**

NCAA reserves the right of refusal if accepted entry is not what was represented in the entry photograph, or in the case of 2D artwork, does not meet framing requirements. The Vault Gallery is not responsible for the exhibition. Comments are to be directed to the NCAA exhibition committee.

#### METHOD OF ENTRY

Applications are available to print from the NCAA website. Digital photos of submitted work must be a minimum of 1500 x 1500 pixels and high-resolution images (300 dpi) in JPG format. Photos should portray an accurate representation of the piece itself (do not include the frame in the digital photo you submit). #### EXHIBIT CALENDAR

**EXHIBITION OPENS:** Thursday, June 22, 2023, and runs through Friday, July 21, 2023. Viewing hours are Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays, from 1 PM – 4 PM.

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** Applications must be RECEIVED by **Monday, April 10, 2023.**

**ACCEPTANCE LETTERS:** Emailed to Artists by May 1, 2023.

**ARTWORK CHECK-IN:** Monday, June 12, 2023, 11:00 AM – 1:00 PM at the Wadsworth Auditorium's Vault Gallery.

**EXHIBITION CLOSURES:** Friday, July 21, 2023.

**ARTWORK PICK-UP:** Saturday, July 22, 2023, 11:00 AM – 1:00 PM at the Vault Gallery. All artwork **must be** picked up by the Artist or Artist's representative. No exceptions!

#### EXHIBIT MANDATORIES

**Vault Gallery Duties:** The UWG Vault Gallery operates solely through student volunteerism each semester (it does not employ permanent staff). Therefore, the responsibility for viewing the NCAA-AFO (summer) art exhibit falls upon the NCAA members. ALL NCAA Artists, who enter this exhibition, are required to volunteer to work a minimum of two 3-hour shifts.

**Eligibility:** The Vault Gallery can display approximately TWENTY-FIVE (25) 2-dimensional artworks on the walls and FOUR (4) 3-dimensional artworks placed on pedestals. Acceptance into the exhibit will be determined by the order (day and time) each application is received via email, until all applicable gallery spaces are full.

#### SALES

Submitted artwork may be marked "Not for Sale ("NFS")." All sales will be handled solely by the Artist. No commission is involved. Sold works are to remain in the exhibit until it closes.

#### STATEMENT OF LIABILITY

Artwork will be handled with utmost care. The NCAA, the Vault Gallery, or any participating exhibitor or volunteer cannot be held responsible for damage or loss. NCAA and the Vault Gallery reserve the right to photograph entries for publicity purposes. NCAA and the Vault Gallery do not insure the artwork.
